

Research Paper Title : The Sangha Administration of Sangha Administrators in
Bangyai District, Nonthaburi Province

ABSTRACT

The objectives of this research were : 1) to study the opinions of monks to the sangha administration of sangha administrators in Bangyai district, Nonthaburi province, 2) to study the comparison of the sangha administration of sangha administrators in Bangyai district, Nonthaburi province, 3) to study the problems and suggestions about the sangha administration of sangha administrators in Bangyai district, Nonthaburi province. The sampling group was 203 monks in Bangyai district, Nonthaburi province. The research is a mixed research methodology between quantitative and qualitative researches. The statistics are used for the data analysis through such as percentage, mean, standard deviation (S.D), F-test, One-way Analysis of Variance and Least Significant Difference : LSD., and the data analysis from interview was used by the content analysis technique.

The findings of this research as follows :

1. The monks had the opinions to the sangha administration of sangha administrators in Bangyai district, Nonthaburi province, It is at the good level for overall with an average as 3.594. When considered in each side, found that the highest side was the Sangha Activity and administration management with an average at 3.607 and the lowest opinions side was the new member with an average at 3.557.

2. The findings of comparison of the opinions of the monks to the sangha administration of sangha administrators in Bangyai district, Nonthaburi province, classified by personal data and tested the hypothesis, found that the monks were the questionnaire correspondents who had the difference of age, ordination year, general education and Dhamma education, had the opinions of monks to the sangha administration of sangha administrators in Bangyai district, Nonthaburi province differently with significance of statistics at 0.05. It accepted the hypothesis. But the monks who had the difference of the degree of Pali education, had the opinions to the sangha administration of sangha administrators in Bangyai district, Nonthaburi province indifferently. It rejected the hypothesis.

3. The problems and obstacles about the monks who had the sangha administration of sangha administrators in Bangyai district, Nonthaburi province, and found that the abbots lack of leadership for management, abbots are not strict and the monks do not cooperate in Sangha activity, lacked of justice to judge the Sangha administrators. For suggestion, should set up the rule and regulation to welcome the monks to live in the temple, should have the staff to lose the participation of religious activity and should set up the clear temple rules and should support the monks to participate the judge the conflict matter. The guidelines to support to the sangha administration of sangha administrators in Bangyai district, Nonthaburi province, found that Upachaya (Great Master) had the power to consider the people to the end of ordination. The activity should have clearly the rule and regulation for participation and harmony. The sangha management should focus on the principle more than the individual and the way to stop the dispute, should let the guardians come to compromise or solve the problem.
